

# Skin

## **Malignant melanoma**

suspicious pigmented lesion with a weighted 7-point checklist score of 3 or more:

Major features (scoring 2 points each)

Changed in size     Irregular shape     Irregular colour

Minor features (scoring 1 point each)

> 7mm     Inflammation     Oozing     Change in sensation

dermoscopy suggests melanoma of the skin

pigmented or non-pigmented skin lesion that suggests nodular melanoma

## **Squamous cell carcinoma**

skin lesion that raises the suspicion of squamous cell carcinoma or where SCC is in your differential (eg keratoacanthoma or atypical wart).

## **Basal cell carcinoma**

Only refer if there is a concern that a delay will have a significant impact because of factors such as size or site (e.g. tip of nose, near eye, upper lip) or pattern of growth (e.g. large, infiltrative, growing fast)
